Curious what he was doing for his Hawaii patients I attempted to check that web site - [www.medicalmarijuanaofhawaii.com](http://www.medicalmarijuanaofhawaii.com) - It is no longer active. When you click on the link for the "clinics" under the SD MMJ website here [http://mmofsd.com/mmofsd\\_jimenez.php](http://mmofsd.com/mmofsd_jimenez.php) the hawaii web site is gone. The telephone number he used to use here in hawaii 888.215.herb is busy 24/7/365 - fair to say it is 'gone' too, apparently.

I have read that Dr Jimenez is now the ASA "medical advisor" - but as a patient of his here in Hawaii I am at a 100% loss as to what is going on for the Hawaii patients he has written recs for? I have gotten no notification by telephone, email, or postal service.

I was hoping maybe someone could explain the situation with Dr Jimenez and his Hawaii written recs?

I just want to be informed if there has been a change I am not aware of here locally. This web site [http://mmofsd.com/mmofsd\\_jimenez.php](http://mmofsd.com/mmofsd_jimenez.php) spells out whats going on with his CA patients perfectly but is completely devoid of anything related to Hawaii patient status.

Very odd.

Seems the easiest of tasks is alot to ask from Dr jimenez. Truth be told this has not always been the case but the past doesnt mean much today.

Dr. Jimenez is not on island right now, he will be back in the Ewa Beach clinic the 21st through the 23rd.

The Hawaii website is down right now and is being worked on, but it does not have anything to do with California. A couple months ago Dr. Jimenez sold his practices over in California to Dr. Blake, and is in the process of moving back to Hawaii permanently shortly.

As for Dr. Jimenez's California license revocation, it is being appealed and he will go to court in September to get his license back. This has nothing to do with his Hawaii license, and if anything were to happen here in Hawaii, emergency arrangements have already been made to insure that the Hawaii patients recommendations are not in jeopardy if an unscrupulous investigator attempts to commit perjury in an investigation to prevent Dr. Jimenez from registering any more patients as they are trying to do in California.

Any time one doctor personally writes over 12,000 recommendations as Dr. Jimenez has, the "powers that be" will do whatever they can to put an end to it, even by lying if they have to.

Dr. Jimenez's Hawaii patients have nothing to worry about, his Ewa Beach office is not closing, and he will soon be living here and have the office open more frequently so that he can see even more patients.

While the California Osteopathic Medical Board does not make their rulings accessible on the web like the regular Medical Board does, they are public documents and are available for a small fee

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for the copies and postage. I've obtained the Jimenez ruling and have scanned and posted it online here:
